Mr. White held the attention of the students from the beginning of the program through the end and the impact it had on them was apparent and obvious.

During this message many of the students were in tears and quite emotional. It was truly awesome to observe this response.

The assembly was two hours long, and as I stated above, the students were attentive and captivated through the entire program. Many students stayed in the gymnasium for more than half an hour after its conclusion because they wanted more.
